WHEREAS a comprehensive review of water and sewer expenses, as well as a projected 5 year capital plan was completed in 2020; and

WHEREAS these projections were analyzed through utility rate models to determine the rates for the water and sewer rate payers.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached Stratford Utility tariff for 2021, which incorporates the following, be hereby approved:

- the water for a single family dwelling (SFD) will remain at $\$ 82.05$ per quarter as of April 2021;
- The sewer for a single family dwelling (SFD) will remain at $\$ 122.86$ per quarter as of April 2021;
- the consumption charge for metered water will remain at $\$ 0.9680$ per cubic metre as of April 2021; and
- the consumption charge for metered sewer will remain at $\$ 1.4530$ per cubic meter as of April 2021.

This resolution bears the recommendation of the Finance committee as discussed at a meeting held on March 16, 2021.

# STRATFORD UTILITY CORPORATION <br> TARIFF <br> EfFective April 1, 2021 

## AUTHORITY

This tariff is enacted by resolution of Council pursuant to Town of Stratford Bylaw \# 21, the Water and Sewer Customer Service Regulation Bylaw.

## Application

The following schedule of rates and charges shall apply to all properties located in the Town of Stratford that are served by the Stratford Utility Corporation, or that are capable of being served by the Stratford Utility Corporation.

## Un-Metered Rates

All un-metered customers shall be subject to the following rates for water and sewer:
Water: $\$ 82.05$ per quarter ( $\$ 328.20$ per year) per equivalent unit
Sewer: $\$ 122.86$ per quarter (\$491.44 per year) per equivalent unit
Where the equivalent units are calculated in accordance with the equivalent units table at the end of this tariff.

## Vacant Lot Rates

Water: $\$ 25.44$ per quarter ( $\$ 101.76$ per year) per lot
Sewer: $\$ 38.09$ per quarter ( $\$ 152.36$ per year) per lot

## Septic Tank Effluent Sewer Pump and Lift Pump Tariff Reduction

Sewer customers who are connected via a septic tank effluent sewer pump system are eligible for a reduction in the tariff of $\$ 37.50$ per quarter ( $\$ 150.00$ per year). These customers shall be responsible to supply, own and maintain the septic tanks and pumping systems.

Sewer customers who require a lift pump to lift the sewerage from the main level of the building that fronts the street where the sewer line is located are eligible for a reduction in the tariff of $\$ 31.00$ per quarter ( $\$ 124.00$ per year). These customers shall be responsible to supply, own and maintain the lift pumps.

## FRONTAGE CHARGES

Properties along which a water line or sewer line front shall be subject to frontage charges for the distance the line fronts the property over 125 feet as follows:

Water: $\$ .2544$ per foot per quarter ( $\$ 1.0176$ per foot per year)
Sewer: $\$ .3809$ per foot per quarter ( $\$ 1.5236$ per foot per year)

Where:

- All lots shall be billed for frontage over 125 feet only;
- corner lots shall be billed the average length of both sides with the short side deemed to be the length of that side or 125 feet, whichever is greater, regardless of whether the line fronts the full length of that side or not;
- frontage for properties assessed as farm properties shall not exceed 100 feet.
- Lots which are located on the inside curve of a long radius sweep shall be considered a corner lot.


## Fire Rated Water Charges

Properties that are required to have fire rated water systems shall be subject to an annual charge of $\$ .06$ per square foot of sprinklered billing area.

## Metered Rates

All non-residential customers who are serviced by water only or water and sewer shall be metered and shall be subject to the following rates for water and sewer service based on the water meter readings.
