### **General Notes for Erosion and Sedimentation Control During Construction**

The Developer undertakes and agrees to carry out the said development in compliance with the Town of Stratford Zoning and Development Bylaw #45, Section 7.4.1.(1), in accordance with the application and any plans submitted and approved for the development and in compliance with any specific or additional CONDITIONS AS DESCRIBED HEREON, OR ATTACHED HERETO.

- Do not remove or disturb any vegetation outside the areas for construction as part of this permit.
- Developer to divert as much "clean" water around the site as possible and prevent it from picking up silt as it crosses the site.
- Stabilize access roads as soon as possible after being disturbed.
- Erosion control measures must be checked on a regular basis (i.e. at least once every 3 days or immediately after a rainfall event).
- All measures must be taken by the general contractor to prevent any sedimentation from leaving the site during construction.
- Any mud or debris that is carried out onto the public roadway must be cleaned off at the end of each workday.
- Failure to comply with the erosion and sedimentation controls as outlined in this plan can result in a stop work order until adequate measures have been corrected.
